

Toasts & Toasting Etiquette

1. Make sure all glasses are filled before toasting.

2. The glasses don't have to hold alcohol; non-drinkers may toast with water, juice, or a soft drink.

3. Get the crowd's attention by standing and raising your glass (not by banging on your glass).

4. Traditionally, the first toast is offered by the host as a welcome to guests.

5. When toasted, the "toastee" does not stand, nor does she drink to herself.

6. Make sure to keep your toast short and on point.
